The Irish Building Control Institute is pleased to present the IBCI Building Control Conference 2024. The Conference will provide an update on current developments for those involved in Building Control throughout Ireland and an opportunity to network with colleagues.

We are delighted to report that feedback from IBCI Conference 2023 in Athlone was excellent, and we look forward to welcoming you all back to Sligo 2024 .

The Conference will be held over two days in the Radisson Blu Hotel, Sligo. Lunch and refreshments will be provided on both days, with the Conference Dinner on Wednesday evening. A Trade Exhibition will also be held in conjunction with the Conference.

The Conference will focus on the emerging developments and implementation of the Building Control System, the Building Regulations and Market Surveillance.
