Inspections-Challenges

Main Issue: Competency of Staff

- All new/existing staff must complete the <u>Certificate</u> in <u>Building Control Management</u>, approved by the CCMA as the recommended minimum competency for Building Control staff
- Building Control Inspection must have allocated days (or times) for the Site visits. To ensure Compliance with Building Control/Building Regulations
- FSC and DAC, a Risk based number of inspections must be carried out to ensure compliance
- Specific Training for Inspectors &
- Review of Inspection Programme, Protocol

The primary purpose of the CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS REGULATION is to break down technical barriers to trade to ensure the free movement of construction products across Member States

'MARKET SURVEILLANCE' means the activities carried out and measures taken by a market surveillance authority to ensure that construction products comply with the requirements set out in the Construction Products Regulation and do not endanger health, safety or any other aspect of public interest protection; <u>Market surveillance (europa?eu)</u>



Market Surveillance of Construction Products- the future

Status Update: Revision to the Construction Products Regulations

- The Office is currently preparing an information campaign to assist Market Surveillance Authorities & Economic Operators for upcoming revisions to the <u>Regulation (EU) 305/2011</u> The Construction Products Regulation (CPR).
- On 30 March 2022, the European Commission put forward a proposal to revise the CPR. The proposal was part of a package aimed at making sustainable products the norm in the EU and boosting circular business models.
- The stated aims of the proposal are to improve the functioning of the internal market for construction products, address the implementation challenges that still exist at national level (particularly regarding market surveillance), simplify the legal framework and support the green and digital transition in the construction sector.

Challenges Market Surveillance of Construction Products

Donegal Petition Committee report sets out six recommendations:

- The large scale and complexity of the use of defective building blocks used in construction in Ireland, as well as its severe health, financial and social consequences, amounts to an ongoing housing crisis, which should be urgently tackled.
- Need to ensure that this situation will never occur again, not only in Ireland but also in any EU member state. It is the responsibility of the public authorities to safeguard people's well-being and health, by exploiting all the available tools under the legal and policy framework at national and EU level, according to the principle of subsidiarity.
- The market surveillance system in Ireland, both at national and local level, needs to be enhanced, adopting a stance that is proactive and persuasive, rather than reactive, and involving all the stakeholders.
- The role and capacity of the National Building Control and Market Surveillance Office needs to be strengthened, ensuring that it is sufficiently staffed.
- The Enhanced Defective Concrete Blocks Grant Scheme is a very ambitious and comprehensive plan.
- There is a need for a clearer picture when it comes to identifying and holding accountable the persons and entities responsible for this situation.




Figure 12: Driving Rain Index for Vertical Surfaces (I.S. EN ISO 15927-3:2009) for the period 1991 - 2020 for the Republic of Ireland. Illustrated classes of exposure: very sheltered (< 20), sheltered (20 - 25), moderate (25 - 30), severe (30 - 35), very severe (35 - 40) and extreme (40 - 45).


